## **DOES GOD HOLD GRUDGES?**

## Learning from the life of Paul

- 1. Before he met Jesus, the apostle Paul was a zealous Israelite. What do these verses teach us about Paul's pre-Christian life?

  Acts 22:3-4, Galatians 1:13-14 & Philippians 3:4-6
- 2. Read *Acts 8:1-3, 9:1-2 & 21, 22:19-20*. What were some of the violent acts Paul committed against Jesus' followers?
- 3. And yet... God chose to forgive Paul, to wipe away his sin and to make him a partner in the work of restoring sinners. Read Paul's later description of his conversion in *Acts 22:6-21* (Acts 9 retells the same story, with some extra details).
  - What do you think he was thinking about before Ananias appeared?
  - Do you think you'd have Ananias's faith to go to known persecutor to speak God's Word?
  - What's involved in becoming a believer according to Ananias (v. 16)?
  - What was God's mission for Paul? (vss. 14-16, 21).
- 4. Why would God do that? Read Paul's insight in 1 Timothy 1:15-16.
  - Who did Christ come into the world to save?
  - Is there a limit to His salvation?
  - Why would He save even the worst of sinners?
- 5. Does Paul dwell on his past sins? Read *Philippians 3:13-14*. What does he do instead?
- 6. Based on Paul's experience, what do you think? **Does God hold grudges?**
- 7. What do this mean for you?
